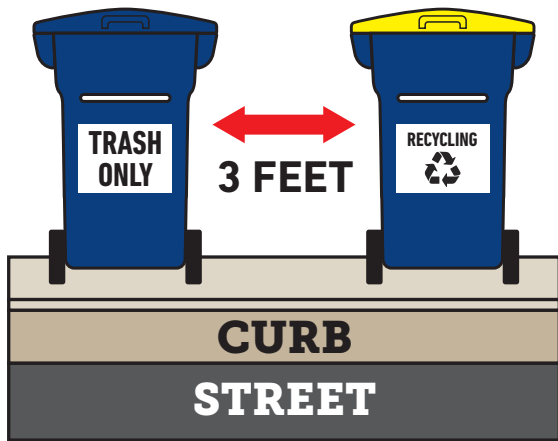


IMPORTANT! Tips on Mobile Cart Placement



Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed BEHIND THE CURB and not on the street. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans.

Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- ◆ Set mobile cart out the night before your pick up day.
- ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid opening towards the road.
- ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway.
- ◆ DO NOT block walkways with carts.
- ◆ Place carts at least THREE FEET APART from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.

Dear Rapho Township Customer:

Beginning in June, Penn Waste will be delivering mobile carts at no charge for trash and recycling collection to all residents serviced under the municipal contract with Rapho Township. Customers currently leasing a trash cart will receive a recycling cart and will no longer be charged for their existing trash cart as of June 30.

Residents will receive one free 96 gallon cart for trash service. This cart has a blue body and a blue lid. Residents will also receive one free 64 gallon mobile cart for recycling service. This cart has a blue body and a yellow lid. Please see the photos included. **The use of the mobile carts is mandatory to ensure collection.** All waste must be placed in the mobile cart unless an extra service tag or oversized item red tag is included on the excess material. To schedule collection of oversized items with red tags attached, please contact Rapho Township at 717-665-3827.

The use of the mobile carts is mandatory because Penn Waste will be collecting residents in Rapho Township with an automated truck. This type of truck uses a mechanical arm to collect material, without the crew member getting out of the truck to collect the material. By utilizing the mobile carts, this will allow our crews to more efficiently collect your material. **Thank you for your cooperation.**
